Missing Metropolitan Areas

A number of metropolitan areas were not included in the comparative analysis because of missing data for specific offenses. Forcible rape statistics were not available for metropolitan areas in Minnesota and Illinois. Aggravated assault data were not reported for the Albuquerque, NM; Atlanta-Sandy Springs, Marietta, GA; Fort Smith, AR-OK; and Jacksonville, FL metro areas. Motor vehicle theft statistics were not reported for Dalton, GA; Detroit-Warren-Livonia, MI (M.S.A); Detroit-Livonia-Dearborn, MI (M.D.), and Wilmington, NC.

Another group of metropolitan areas were not included the comparative analysis because the FBI did not include them in its 2007 *Crime in the United States* report.
